HOW TO GET TO CARDIFF CITY STADIUM

RAIL

Fans wishing to travel by train are advised that *Arriva Trains Wales* operate a half-hourly service to Grangetown Railway station (only a 15 minute walk from Cardiff City Stadium). Details of services can be found by visiting the Cardiff City App or nationalrail.co.uk

CARDIFF BUS

If you are travelling to the game by bus, the Cardiff City matchday shuttle service runs from Cardiff city centre (Wood Street - outside Central Bus & Rail Station) to the stadium (see page 5 for pick-up and drop-off point).

The Cardiff Bus service begins two hours before kick-off, with the last departure from Wood Street being twenty minutes before kick-off. Following the final whistle, buses pick up from near to the Fred Keenor statue at CCS with the first bus departing five minutes after full time. The service continues for an hour after the game has finished. Full details of the Cardiff Bus service can be found at cardiffbus.com

HOW TO GET TO CARDIFF CITY STADIUM







BY CAR

If you're coming to Cardiff City Stadium for the first time, then finding us from the M4 is easy. Leave the M4 at junction 33 and take the A4232 towards Cardiff/Barry. Exit the A4232 on the B4267 turn off, signposted towards Cardiff City Stadium. Follow the slip-road off the B4267, take the first available exit off the roundabout and Cardiff City Stadium will then be on your right. Our postcode is CF11 8AZ.

MATCHDAY PARKING

If traveling by car, please be aware that parking is limited at Cardiff City Stadium and is only available up until half hour prior to kick-off. It costs £8.00 per car on a first come first served basis, with seasonal parking permits available to purchase from the Ticket Office. Recommended parking options close to the Stadium are at *Gôl Centre* (CF11 8BR) or Bessemer Road Market (CF11 8BA), both approximately ten minutes walk from Cardiff City Stadium. Cardiff City FC politely asks all those attending events at CCS to respect local residents by not parking in a way that obstructs footways and/or private entrances. Cardiff Council enforcement officers and South Wales Police officers work event days and will check that all vehicles are parked legally.

USW STAND

We host live music and entertainment in the USW stand on matchdays, helping to build the atmosphere in the lead up to kick-off. We also have a 10' projector for fans to enjoy the best of Cardiff City TV and televised matches, with further technological and visual developments in CCS continuing and evolving around the Stadium.

GRANDSTAND

The concourse areas within the Grandstand have additional seating for those who wish to rest their legs away from the elements before the match and at half-time. In addition, we ensure that the internal concourse areas are kept suitably warm.

NINIAN STAND

The Ninian Stand provides a great view of the pitch whilst offering a photographic timeline in the concourse. This nostalgic trip gives fans of all ages a chance to soak up the club's history. There are no restrictions stopping you from walking around to the USW Stand and enjoying the entertainment pre-match though, if that's your thing!

There are currently no cash points inside the stadium. The nearest ATMs can be found outside ASDA in the Leckwith Retail Park (less than a 5 minute walk away from Cardiff City Stadium).

The Cardiff City Away Travel Group is the club's official travel group in association with South Wales Police. All members have to be approved by the police before becoming part of the group and must adhere to clubs' travel policies. The club holds regular meetings to discuss upcoming fixtures and travel plans. No group ticket bookings are to be made via the ticket office unless you are a member of the Away Travel Group. SAFETY & SECURITY

Cardiff City Stadium, in line with all stadia in the City of Cardiff, request that fans come early to venues and allow extra time to pass security controls prior to entry.

Bulky items and large bags should be avoided being brought to the Stadium and due to recent events in continental Europe the left luggage facility previously available at the Stadium has been withdrawn. Visible Police presence within the Stadium will continue to be reduced as far as the match risk assessment allows. However, please note a robust policing operation is always prevalent on the footprint to ensure public safety and reassurance. We ask all supporters and guests to be alert but not alarmed. Everybody at Cardiff City Stadium wants to ensure that we provide a safe, secure and welcoming environment and your assistance by allowing some extra time, while leaving behind large bags and bulky items is very much appreciated.

Superintendent Steve Murray of South Wales Police has said ahead of this season: "Whilst there is currently no specific threat to Cardiff, wider South Wales or sporting events in general, terrorism is a real and ongoing threat to which we must all be vigilant.

"Cardiff City FC, South Wales Police and other partners have a proud tradition of working together to keep everybody safe. We hope that members of the public will support the additional measures undertaken by all parties to ensure the ongoing safety of supporters, local residents and those employed at events."

MANAGEMENT OF PERSISTENT STANDING AT CARDIFF CITY STADIUM

Cardiff City Stadium, in line with all stadia in the City of Cardiff, request that fans come early to venues and allow extra time to pass security controls prior to entry.

For 2019/20, the policy of the Club will be to take all reasonable steps in accordance with the SGSA's enforcement approach, thus ensuring compliance with the all-seater licence conditions at Cardiff City Stadium, providing that these are practicable and do not create unacceptable risks to other aspects of safety, security and service.

Where all reasonable steps have been taken, but spectators still choose to stand in seated areas in any part of the stadium, the Club will use appropriate additional steps to manage residual safety risk for those spectators who still choose to stand in seated areas.

HISTORY





Cardiff City FC play at Cardiff City Stadium, having moved from former home Ninian Park in 2009.

Ninian Park was the home of the *Bluebirds* for almost a century, with the team having first started playing there in 1910.

Cardiff City FC is the only non-English club to have won the F.A. Cup, lifting the famous trophy in 1927. The *Bluebirds* also have an impressive recent history in cup competitions, reaching the 2008 F.A. Cup Final & 2012 League Cup final.

Cardiff City FC have twice been in the Premier League: for the 2013/14 season and, most recently, 2018/19.
